PASTOR’S REFLECTION

The early Church needed to be shown that Jesus’ association with John was friendly and that like John, his disciples should give due recognition to Jesus, and not hold on to the belief that John was the one to come. The announcement of the baptism of Jesus is needed for the people and especially for the believers in the early church.

If all of us, baptized Christians, believe we will live one day together in God’s love in heaven we have to prove this belief by living as brothers and sisters here on earth. Baptism is not a big flood that washes away all past evil. Baptism is an ongoing commitment to one’s mission here on earth. Time and again it needs the gentle rain of daily prayer, the whisper of the Holy Spirit, the cooperation with God’s benevolent love.

CHRIST THE KING CHURCH – HISPANIC COMMUNITY

Domingo 12 de Enero del 2025.
(El bautismo de Jesus).

Hermanas y hermanos, Cristo es el Hijo de Dios. Mas esa afirmación central no anula otras que son posibles, que vienen de la Escritura y que hacen mucho bien a nuestro entendimiento del misterio de Jesucristo; entre estos otros enunciados hoy vamos a centrarnos en Cristo como "Siervo" de Dios.

Partamos de una base: proclamar el señorío de Dios es proclamar nuestra servidumbre hacia Dios. ¿Qué es, en efecto, un señor sin siervos? ¿Hay algo más ridículo que un señor que no tiene quién atienda a sus órdenes ni quién quiera agradarle con sus acciones? Si tomamos en serio que Dios es Señor hemos de tomar en serio que nosotros somos siervos suyos. Y tal es el mensaje de Cristo: mostrándose en obras y palabras como verdadero Siervo de Dios mostró con sus palabras y con sus obras que Dios es el Señor, es decir, mostró que Dios reina; nos dejó ver el Reino de Dios.

Isaías, en la primera lectura de hoy, nos presenta un perfil de un siervo de Dios. De todas las características que él menciona, detengámonos en una, o mejor en la combinación de dos de ellas: compasivo y fuerte. No rompe la caña resquebrajada y a la vez manifiesta firmemente el derecho. Entiende al cansado pero no se cansa; acoge al caído mientras conserva su propio lugar y su propia misión. ¡Admirable virtud, que bien vemos brillar en Jesucristo!

¿Qué es lo peculiar de Cristo? ¿Cristo es Cristo porque tiene una técnica mental, una tecnología única, un saber esotérico o por qué? Esta fiesta del bautismo del Señor nos conduce al corazón de la respuesta: lo propio de Jesús es la Unción que ha recibido. Un enunciado muy sencillo, que sin embargo tiene consecuencias inmensas. Si lo peculiar de Cristo fuera una técnica mental entonces ser cristiano significaría ser mentalista. En sentido contrario: si lo peculiar de Cristo es la unción del Espíritu Santo, y ese Espíritu viene a habitar en nosotros, entonces ser cristiano es básicamente participar del Espíritu de Jesús, cosa que no suena nada discordante de lo que enseña Pablo: "porque todos los que son guiados por el Espíritu de Dios, los tales son hijos de Dios" (Rom 8,14). ¡Dios Santo! Todo está en la acción del Espíritu Santo en nosotros, y el primero, y quien ha inaugurado ese camino para nosotros, es Jesucristo.
