**Day 1 – Friday, October 31, 2025**

**DEPART MAUI**

Today we depart Maui on DL394 at 9:10am.

**Day 2 – Saturday, November 1, 2025**

**DEPART MAUI**

Arrive Seattle at 5:59am and connect with AF337 at 2:35pm.

**Day 3 – Sunday, November 2, 2025**

**MILAN**

Arrive Paris at 8:15a and continue with AF1130 at 10:10am to Milan, arriving at 11:40am. After checking through immigration and customs, meet our guide and bus driver. We will have a tour of Milan before continuing to our hotel dinner and overnight.

**Day 4 – Monday, November 3, 2025**

**MILAN / PADUA**

After breakfast, we have a morning tour of Milan. We then drive towards Verona and visit the Santuario Madonna Della Corona. Afterwards we celebrate Mass, then continue our drive to the hotel in Padua for dinner and overnight.

**Day 5 – Tuesday, November 4, 2025**

**PADUA / VENICE / PADUA**

After early breakfast, we celebrate Mass at St Antony's Basilica. Afterwards, we drive to Venice, to visit the Golden Basilica of San Marco, the Bridge of Sighs, St. Mark's Square and the Doges' Palace. The balance of the day is free to explore Venice on your own, before returning to Padua. In Padua, we visit the tomb inside San Antony's Basilica. One of the Catholic Church's greatest preachers, his incorrupt tongue is kept in the Chapel of Reliquaries. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 6 – Wednesday, November 5, 2025**

**PADUA / FLORENCE**

After breakfast and checkout, we drive to Florence. Here we enjoy a city tour, including the Piazza Del Duomo, Duomo di Santa Maria del Fiore, the Baptistery of San Giovanni and the Bell Tower. At days end we head to the hotel for check in, dinner and overnight in Florence.

**Day 7 – Thursday, November 6, 2025**

**FLORENCE / SIENA / ASSISI**

After breakfast and checkout, we spend some time in Florence before departing to Siena, the birthplace of Saint Catherine and Bernadine. Here we stroll the Piazza del Campo, visit the Cathedral and the Basilica of St. Francis, which contains the miraculous consecrated host that remained intact since 1730. We also visit the Basilica of St. Dominic and celebrate Mass. Lastly, we continue to Assisi for hotel check in, dinner and overnight.

**Day 8 – Friday, November 7, 2025**

**ASSISI**

After breakfast, we visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement, to view her remains and see the miraculous Crucifix. Celebrate Mass. In the afternoon, we continue to the Sanctuary of the Esposizione, to see the Blessed Carlo Acutis. From here, we walk to the Basilica of St. Francis to explore the Basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. We follow this with time at leisure for shopping or personal activities. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 9 – Saturday, November 8, 2025**

**ASSISI / LORETO / LANCIANO / SAN GIOVANNI**

After breakfast and checkout, we visit the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels and the place where the Eucharistic Miracle took place in 1240. We see the Porziuncola (small church) and the Chapel of Transit. We continue to Cascia, to visit the Basilica of St. Rita, the Chapel with her incorrupt body, the Eucharistic Miracle, and the Relics of St. Rita (including her wedding ring and habit). We then head to Loreto to visit the family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph located inside the Basilica of Loreto, where it has been since 1294. We drive to the Lancia Holy Miracle which resides in the Sanctuary of the Eucharistic Miracle near the Piazza Plebiscito. Afterwards, we drive to the hotel in San Giovanni Rotondo for check in, dinner and overnight.

**Day 10 – Sunday, November 9, 2025**

**SAN GIOVANNI / MONT SAINT ANGELO / ST MICHAEL'S CAVE**

This morning, we see the places associated with Saint Pio, including his room, confessional, the Crucifix from which Saint Pio received the Stigmata and the Grotto of Michael the Archangel. Many Popes have knelt in prayer here seeking the protection of St. Michael. We then drive a short distance and enjoy a breathtaking view of the Gargano Peninsula on our way to the village of Monte Sant' Angelo. Here we visit the Cave of St. Michael. Six different popes, Saint Francis and at least four other saints have knelt in prayer at this grotto where St. Michael appeared in the 4th century. This is the only building of worship in the Roman Catholic Church not consecrated by humans. It was consecrated by St. Michael himself. Afterwards, we return to San Giovanni for dinner and overnight.

**Day 11 – Monday, November 10, 2025**

**SAN GIOVANNI / MONTE CASSINO / ROME**

Following breakfast, we travel through the rich Italian countryside of vineyards, orchards, and olive groves. We stop in Montecassino, to visit the Abbey where St. Benedict and his sister St. Scholastica are buried. We tour the magnificent Abbey of Monte Cassino, where the Benedictine Order was founded by St. Benedict. We then continue to Rome and check in to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 12 – Tuesday, November 11, 2025**

**ROME / VATICAN MUSEUMS**

This morning, we have a panoramic tour of Imperial Rome. We see the Colosseum (outside), continue to visit San Paul Outside the Walls, celebrate Mass, enter the 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Door and, see the Basilica which houses San Paul's bones and also his miraculous chain. We drive to the Vatican to visit the Museums and enter the 2<sup>nd</sup> Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica. We return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 13 – Wednesday, November 12, 2025**

**ROME / PAPAL AUDIENCE**

After an early breakfast, we head to Vatican City to join pilgrims from around the world, for an audience with His Holiness, the Pope (subject to the Holy Father's schedule and health). In the afternoon, we head to Navona Square to see the Pantheon (outside), and Santa Maria Sopra Minerva. We celebrate Mass then return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 14 – Thursday, November 13, 2025**

**ROME**

After breakfast, we head to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, walking through the 3<sup>rd</sup> Holy Door of our pilgrimage, and visit the Basilica, which is one of the oldest and most important shrines in the world dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We continue on to the Basilica of St. John in Lateran and walk through the 4<sup>th</sup> Holy Door of our trip. This Basilica is the seat of the bishop of Rome, who of course, is also the Pope. The Basilica houses magnificent artwork and also wood from the table used at the Last Supper. From here we walk to the Shrine of the Holy Stairs, so named because they are the steps which led to the praetorium of the Roman Procurator Pontius Pilato. We then see the Trevi Fountain before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Day 15 – Friday, November 14, 2025**

**DEPART FOR USA**

After breakfast, we drive to the airport for our return flights to Maui. KL1600 departing at 6:10am, arriving Amsterdam at 8:45am. Continue with DL143 at 10:15am to Seattle, arriving at 11:50am. Connect with DL344 at 1:35pm, arriving Maui at 5:50pm.
