HISPANIC COMMUNITY

**Domingo 3 de Mayo del 2026. (V
semana de Pascua)**

Hermanas y hermanos, el incidente narrado en la primera lectura de hoy, con aquellas dificultades que llevaron a la elección de los primeros diáconos, sirve bien para mostrarnos con realismo cómo se fue conformando esa realidad compleja y bella que llamamos la Iglesia. De un modo más profundo, nos ayuda a ver en su esplendor la vocación de los apóstoles: "No nos parece bien descuidar la palabra de Dios para ocuparnos de la administración... Nosotros nos dedicaremos a la oración y al servicio de la palabra." Por una parte hay aquí un reconocimiento de la necesidad de administrar y velar por cosas que pueden parecer secundarias pero que interesan a la vida de los fieles, y en ese sentido, interesan también a la obra del Evangelio en ello. Por otra parte, sin embargo, queda claro que la tarea del apóstol es la oración y la predicación.

Arriba de la piedra estás seguro y salvado; debajo de ella, estás perdido sin remedio. La piedra es Cristo y estar sobre la piedra es tomarla como cimiento de tu vida; es el resultado de creer en Cristo y saber que nos podemos fiar de su palabra. Estar bajo ella es recibir el peso de su juicio al final de nuestros días, pues es una realidad que El mismo que hoy ofrece, salvación al final traerá juicio.

La idea de Pedro va más allá: también nosotros entramos "como piedras vivas." No cambiamos el fundamento único y decisivo, que es Cristo, pero sí llegamos a servir de apoyo para que otros, puestos sobre nosotros, puedan encontrar su propio lugar. Es una imagen bella: las piedras más fuertes se reservan para la base, y su función es humilde y casi oculta, pero indispensable para el resto del edificio. Así también en la Iglesia nadie sobra y el más robusto está al servicio del más pequeño.

Las palabras de Cristo en el evangelio de hoy son de las más conocidas y justamente recordadas. Es posible que, si hubiera que dar una definición de Cristo, muchos de nosotros tomáramos lo de hoy: Él es "el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida." Bueno es entonces preguntarnos si Cristo es nuestro Camino, es decir, si tomamos nuestras decisiones y opciones siguiendo su modo de decidir y optar; si sus palabras nos iluminan; si acogemos a los que se nos acercan con el corazón que él lo hacía y si rechazamos las tentaciones como él lo hizo. Y preguntemos también si Cristo es nuestra verdad. Si somos capaces de presentar su rostro sin vergüenza estéril y sin orgullo vano de nosotros mismos. Y miremos si él es nuestra vida. Si de veras no tenemos vida cuando él no está; si le buscamos cuando parece que se aleja o si corremos pronto hacia él cuando acaso nos hemos alejado nosotros.

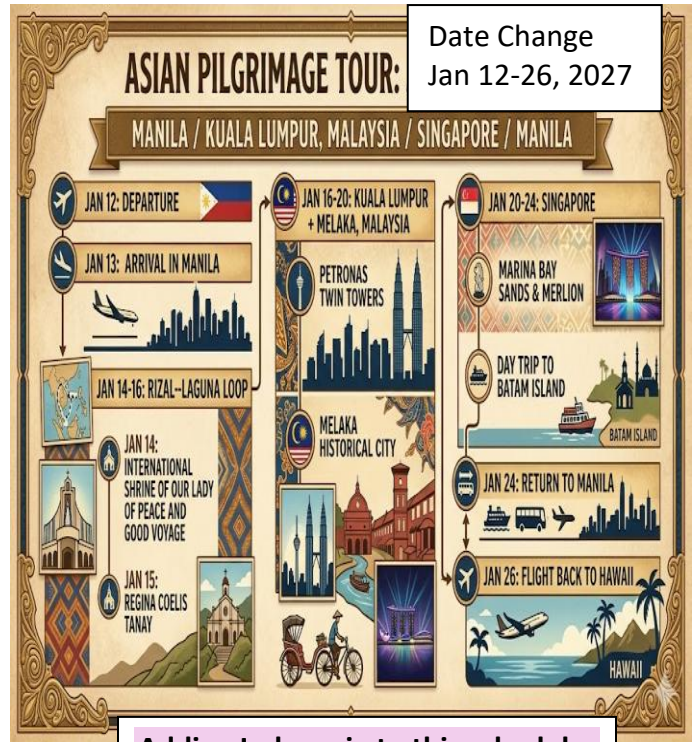
