PASTOR’S REFLECTION



The Feast of Pentecost is the commemoration of the descending, indwelling and transforming act of the Holy Spirit. Jesus had promised to send the Holy Spirit, whom He termed as the Advocate, the Helper, the Teacher and the Comforter. The promise was fulfilled on the day of Pentecost. The consequence of the indwelling of the Holy Spirit was indeed indescribable and dramatic.

The Holy Spirit is indeed the dynamic force who transforms not only the Church but every human person. We have encountered many people whose lives were “renewed” because of the Spirit. Their eyes were opened to realize their frailty and emptiness despite material fullness and satisfaction. They realized that giving up that fullness does not make them empty but contented and happy. Pentecost is not only the feast reminding us of the coming down of the Holy Spirit fifty days after the Resurrection. It is also the birthday of the Church. For it is the Spirit who is the driving force of the Church and every baptized Christian. The Spirit which Jesus gave as a lasting gift to the apostles is the same Spirit at work in our present time.

HISPANIC COMMUNITY



Domingo 24 de Mayo del 2026. (Solemnidad de Pentecostés).

Hermanas y hermanos, son innumerables las enseñanzas que nos ofrece la teología del Espíritu Santo. Hoy queremos dar una mirada a las maravillas que obra el Espíritu, de las que poco hablamos en nuestro contexto católico. Se le llama "don de lenguas" a diferentes dones que se deben distinguir para evitar confusión. El don milagroso de hablar un idioma que no se ha aprendido por la vía natural. Este don se manifestó en Pentecostés, quedaron todos llenos del Espíritu Santo y se pusieron a hablar en otras lenguas, según el Espíritu les concedía expresarse. -Hechos 2:4. Se trata de un don milagroso. San Agustín enseña que en el comienzo de la Iglesia este don era necesario para que el Evangelio se comunicara rápidamente a todas las naciones, así todos podían recibirlo y además se daba testimonio del origen divino de su doctrina. Pero cuando la Iglesia ya hablaba los diferentes lenguajes (por medios naturales) el don se hizo menos necesario.

Profecía en lenguas. Es el don de pronunciar profecías en un lenguaje ininteligible o desconocido por los que están presente. Estas palabras pueden ser interpretadas por alguien con el don de interpretación (sea porque conoce el lenguaje naturalmente o por un don especial). Entonces el mensaje edifica a la iglesia. Si no se interpreta, este don de lenguas se dirige solo a Dios y no a la comunidad. Porque a uno se le da por el Espíritu palabra de sabiduría; ... a otro, poder de milagros; a otro, profecía; a otro, discernimiento de espíritus; a otro, diversidad de lenguas; a otro, don de interpretarlas. (I Corintios 12, 8; 10).

Orar en lenguas o canto de júbilo. Este don es muy diferente a los de arriba. Por medio de él se expresa, con sonidos ininteligibles, la devoción que no se puede poner en palabras. Se ha comparado con el canto gregoriano, cuando este extiende las sílabas en una hermosa armonía de alabanza. A diferencia del don

antes mencionado, este tipo de lenguas pueden ejercerlo varias personas o muchas, de igual manera que se expresa el canto en la comunidad. Mientras unos alaban en lenguas, otros pueden alabar con palabras del vernáculo o cantar. Es un don muy sencillo por el cual el Espíritu Santo nos asiste en la oración, particularmente en la alabanza. Este don se manifiesta con frecuencia en los grupos de oración carismáticos.

Este don de lenguas es a la vez una forma de oración bajo la influencia del Espíritu Santo y bajo el dominio de la voluntad del sujeto. Dios no viola su libertad, por lo que la persona utiliza sus facultades normales. Es por eso que la persona debe rezar en lenguas utilizando su discernimiento en cuanto al momento y la forma apropiada para ejercerlo.
